

# **The Time I Met Tiger Woods**



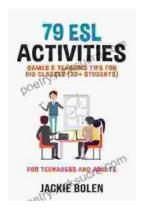

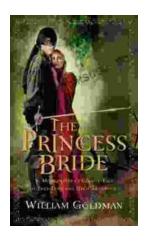
