
Day 21 The Hundred: Trent Rockets Women Make History By Reaching Finals Twice



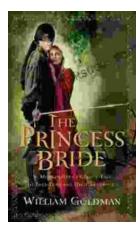
