
Finding Myself Along the Way: A Journey of Self-Discovery and Growth



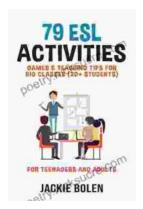

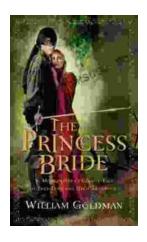
