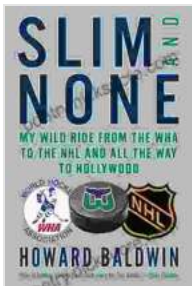


# My Wild Ride From The Wha To The Nhl And All The Way To Hollywood

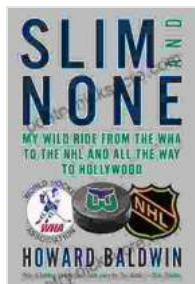

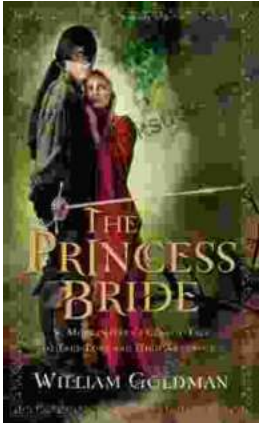
