- Hot Potato: Pass a small object around the group, and then have the person holding the object when the music stops do a silly dance or perform a forfeit.

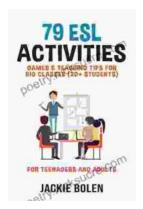

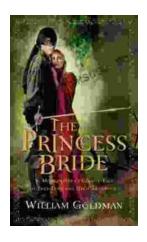
